



2. Students are required to register themselves and upload the required documents with the help of their own unique login ID and password.
3. Respective University Teaching Departments/ Centres/ P.U. Constituent Colleges/ PU Regional Centres are required to verify Scholarship Application Form (Institutional Verification Form) along with supporting documents and also provide the Annual Course Fee detail in the following format for their respective courses:

  - f. Proof of Bank Account in the name of student. (Mandatory) linked with Aadhar Card
  - g. Aadhaar Card (Mandatory)




